

**Maidencreek Township Board of Supervisors
January 4, 2010 – 8:00 PM**

Claude Beaver called the January 4, 2010 Reorganization Meeting of the Maidencreek Township Board of Supervisors to order at 8:01 p.m. in the Maidencreek Township Municipal Building and asked everyone to rise for the Pledge to the Flag.

A motion was made by Joseph Rudderow III, seconded by Roy Timpe, to appoint Claude Beaver as Chairperson Pro Tem and Johanna Mattera as Secretary Pro Tem for the purpose of electing officers for Township of Maidencreek in 2010. All members voted, "Aye." Motion carried.

CHAIRPERSON AND VICE CHAIRPERSON POSITIONS

A motion was made by Roy Timpe, seconded by Joseph Rudderow III, to nominate Claude Beaver as Chairperson of the Maidencreek Township Board of Supervisors in 2010. Hearing no questions on the motion all members voted as follows, Joseph Rudderow III and Roy Timpe "Aye" and Claude Beaver "Abstain." Motion carried.

CAPITAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESOLUTION 7-2010 AND RESOLUTION 8-2010

A motion was made by Joseph Rudderow III, seconded by Roy Timpe, to designate VIST Bank, Fleetwood Bank and Affinity Bank as depositories for Township funds and the collected tax funds of the Maidencreek Township Tax Collector. Hearing no questions on the motion all members voted, "Aye." Motion carried.

A motion was made by Roy Timpe, seconded by Joseph Rudderow III, to authorize the Chairman to sign the Survey of Financial Condition. Hearing no questions on the motion all members voted, "Aye." Motion carried.

A motion was made by Joseph Rudderow III, seconded by Roy Timpe, to authorize the County of Berks to print and mail joint real estate tax bills with the Township sharing equally in the cost for printing and postage. Hearing no questions on the motion all members voted, "Aye." Motion carried.

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A motion was made by Joseph Rudderow III, seconded by Roy Timpe, to authorize any Supervisor to spend funds, not to exceed \$2,500.00, for emergency situations and the Manager to spend funds, not to exceed \$600.00, at any time for daily operational needs during 2010. Hearing no questions on the motion all members voted, "Aye". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Roy Timpe, seconded by Joseph Rudderow III, to authorize the Township Manager to purchase security bonds for 2010 for the Secretary/Treasurer in the amount of \$500,000.00 and Real Estate Tax Collector in the amount of \$500,000.00. Hearing no questions on the motion all members voted, "Aye". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Joseph Rudderow III, seconded by Roy Timpe, to adopt Resolution 7-2010 authorizing the Board to appoint an independent auditor to audit the financial records of 2009. Hearing no questions on the motion all members voted, "Aye". Motion carried.

APPOINT FIRE POLICE PERSONNEL

A motion was made by Roy Timpe, seconded by Joseph Rudderow III, to appoint personnel to the following positions: Fire Police Captain -Floyd Richards, Fire Police Lieutenant – Teresa Franke, Fire Police Sergeant – Greg Vulling, Fire Police Personnel – Dan Miller, Sr. and Michael Kauffman. Hearing no questions on the motion, all members voted, "Aye". Motion carried.

RESOLUTION 8-2010

A motion was made by Joseph Rudderow III, seconded by Roy Timpe, to adopt Resolution 8-2010 authorizing the Bandon Ambulance Service to provide emergency medical service to Maidencreek Township. Hearing no questions on the motion all members voted, "Aye". Motion carried.

Since there was no further business, a motion was made by Roy Timpe, seconded by Joseph Rudderow III, to adjourn the January 4, 2010 Maidencreek Township Reorganization Meeting. Hearing no questions on the motion, all members voted, "Aye." Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:28 p.m.
