

**MAIDENCREEK TOWNSHIP
PARK AND RECREATION BOARD MEETING
Regular Meeting September 3, 2009**

Hether Quillman called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM.

APPROVAL OF PRIOR MEETING MINUTES:

Robert Ramsey made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 30, 2009 Regular Meeting, seconded by David Anspach. Hearing no questions, all voted in favor. The motion passed unanimously.

MANAGER/TREASURER'S REPORT:

The Board reviewed the Manager/Treasurer's report. Diane Hollenbach advised the Board that the Board of Supervisors has authorized \$85,000 for an additional Money Market Account earmarked for the Cornerstone Drive Tot Lot renovation and Community Park Bathroom projects. Mrs. Hollenbach recommends using Affinity Bank for this new account as they had the best interest rates. The Board agrees with her recommendation.

Motion:

Kim Rossetti made a motion to approve the Manager/Treasurer's report, seconded by David Anspach. Hearing no questions, all voted in favor. The motion passed unanimously.

ENGINEER'S REPORT:

The engineer was not in attendance; Diane Hollenbach updated the Board on these items.

Cornerstone Tot Lot Renovation

The equipment and construction costs can both be on State Contract. The Board of Supervisors had requested verification of the warranty start date (point of purchase or point of installation) before determining when to purchase the playground equipment. Mrs. Hollenbach confirmed the warranty begins at point of purchase. She will advise the Supervisors accordingly.

Community Park Restroom Utilities

Mrs. Hollenbach advised the Board that the permit to cross the creek is still pending. The bid request cannot be advertised until the permit has been approved. The water and sewer lines will be coming into the park from Golden Drive.
