ORDINANCE NO. 252
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF MAIDENCREEK, BERKS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, CHAPTER 204, ENTITLED VEHICLES
AND TRAFFIC, TO REMOVE PROHIBITED PARKING ON
INDEPENDENCE COURT.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Maidenecreek, as follows:

Section 1. Section 204-15 of Chapter 204, Vehicles and Traffic of the Code of the Township of Maidenecreek is hereby amended to remove the parking prohibition on Independence Court.

Section 2. Severability.

The provisions of this Article shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal, such decision shall not affect the validity of any remaining provisions of this Article. It is hereby declared that it is the legislative intent that this Article would have been adopted had the unconstitutional or illegal provision had not been included.

Section 3. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days from the date of enactment.
