The responsibility of the Township under its Code of Ordinances and the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is the enforcement of these codes and regulations. The Township is committed to doing so in a careful, efficient, and impartial manner.

To this end, you may reach out to the
Township office with any questions you may
have related to the enforcement of the
Township's regulations, such as the time of
day when noise levels are regulated to
decrease or when a permit is required for work.



The Township also has a confidential complaint form that may be filled out and emailed to the office for the staff to review any matter appropriately. This form offers confidentiality, but not anonymity. Anonymous complaints are difficult to enforce as there could be details or more information the staff requires to judiciously address a concern. Therefore, we ask that members of the community utilize the form in its entirety and not omit information that helps the Township take enforcement action when appropriate.
