## YARD SITE AND CURBSIDE PICKUP



Maidencreek Township provides curbside brush pickup in the Spring and Fall at designated times. This includes branches with a diameter no greater than 18". Ornamental grass and garden plants should not be put out for brush pick-up, these items should be placed out for leaf collection. Leaf collection takes place in the Spring and Fall at designated times. For all those times in between, the Township provides a drop-off site at 61 Lakeshore Drive, next to the Township building. The drop-off site

Please **MAKE SURE** to place your car at the gate or bring your car into the site with you. There is a 3-minute automatic timer that will count down unless you obstruct the gate with your vehicle or re-open it by bringing your car up to the gate.

## Recycling Information

The Township provides curbside recycling pick-up twice a month for all residential dwellings except apartment buildings with more than four units.

Recycling must be placed by the road the evening before pick up. Extra containers and lids are available at no cost at the Township building.



We do not take back old or damaged recycling bins when you need new ones.

Please place the following items in the blue recycling bins: plastic bottles (1-7), steel and aluminum cans, and all colors of unbroken glass jars and bottles. **Rinse** food from cans and bottles and remove the caps and lids before placing them in the bin. Newspapers, magazines, paper, and cardboard should all be placed in the recycling bin as well. Your recycling will NOT be picked up unless it is in a Maiden Creek Township-issued recycling bin.
